### Essential criteria:

- Academic performance:
  - **Grade 12: Bachelor's Pass with a minimum average of 70%**
  - **Tertiary level: A minimum average of 65%**
- Depending on application stage, candidates may be required to undergo screening, shortlisting, interview, and psychometric assessments.
- Preference will be given to applicants from Designated Groups, in line with VWGA's Transformation objectives and Employment Equity Plan.
