PLEASE NOTE NEW INTERNAL DEADLINE - 23 September 2025

The Department of Higher Education & Training (DHET) has released its funding call for applications for Phase 6 (Cohort 1) of the University Staff Doctoral Programme (USDP) for PhD candidates. The main purpose of the USDP is to support **academics and professional staff (PASS)** at South African universities to undertake and complete doctoral studies within a maximum period of five years or less.

A maximum amount of **R500 000** for a period of 3 years of support will be provided to a successful candidate. Funding for USDP support may include the following:

- 1. Registration and tuition fees, if not studying through UCT;
- 2. Research costs;
- 3. Teaching buy-out;
- 4. Travel and accommodation costs (for data collection, international mobility etc.); and
- 5. Conference attendance (a paper or poster must be presented for the candidate to attend).

The following **eligibility criteria** will apply. The applicant should:

- Hold a full-time permanent or long-term contract (minimum of five years) post within the university;
- Be a South African citizen or permanent resident in South Africa (work permit is not permissible);
- Have registered or intends to register for a doctoral degree in the year of application;
- Have achieved an average of 65% or above in the preceding Master's degree.
- Undertake research aligned with national/regional/global research priority areas and development goals.
- Have identified a home institution mentor, who will support and/or endorse the application.

The application process is as follows:

- i. Applications (HERE please download a copy of the application form and save it to your PC) for USDP funding close on the 23 SEPTEMBER 2025. Note that only fully completed applications will be considered. These should include approvals from the relevant Head of Department. Late applications will not be considered.
- ii. Supporting documentation, to be submitted, with the application form as **1 PDF** document are:
 - Three (3) referee letters one of which MUST be from your supervisor or prospective supervisor.
 - Academic records for your postgraduate qualification/s
 - A valid ID copy
 - USDP Application <u>Checklist</u>
- iii. Fully completed applications and supporting documentation should be submitted to ucdp@uct.ac.za
- iv. A maximum of 10 applications may be submitted to the DHET.
- v. Note: DVC approval is only required for shortlisted applications. The UCDP Office will obtain such approval from the DVC: Research on behalf of shortlisted applicants.
- vi. Application outcomes will be communicated as soon as the institution has received a decision from the DHET.
